Dear Parents/Guardians:

You are receiving this letter because you have indicated an interest in online/at-home learning for your child(ren) for the 2021-2022 school year. As we continue our planning for online learning, we are excited to announce that Evergreen Catholic Schools and Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools have entered into a partnership to collaboratively and sustainably serve the needs of students seeking at-home learning opportunities.

**Students interested in online/at-home learning will continue to be registered in their resident schools in their home school division and no additional registration requirements will be necessary.** However, students registered for online in grades one through six will receive instruction via the Evergreen Catholic Schools At-Home Learning Program and students in grades seven through nine will receive instruction via the Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools Online Learning Pathway.

Evergreen Catholic students will follow that division's instructional calendar (with regard to Professional Development days, school breaks, etc.), while Greater St. Albert Catholic students will follow that jurisdiction's calendar. More information will be forthcoming regarding the details of what programming will look like for your child(ren). We are, however, asking for parents registering for at-home learning to commit for the entire school year to ensure program continuity and curricular alignment for their child(ren). Anticipating fewer students registering for at-home learning provides far less flexibility and shifts throughout the year will add challenges to staffing as well. Families will be contacted by their registered school division and will be asked to declare their intent for at-home or in-person learning prior to the end of June.

This partnership will allow our two jurisdictions to ensure that we are able to meet the needs of elementary and junior high school students who choose to learn at home in the fall, while ensuring robust programming delivered in a learning environment that is permeated by faith.

Evergreen Catholic Schools and Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools have a long history of successful collaboration and support. We are looking forward to this opportunity to provide a faith-based education, and serve the at-home and online learning needs of all our grades 1-9 students from both school divisions, during the upcoming school year. Thank you for your interest in at-home/online learning for your child(ren). Blessings.
